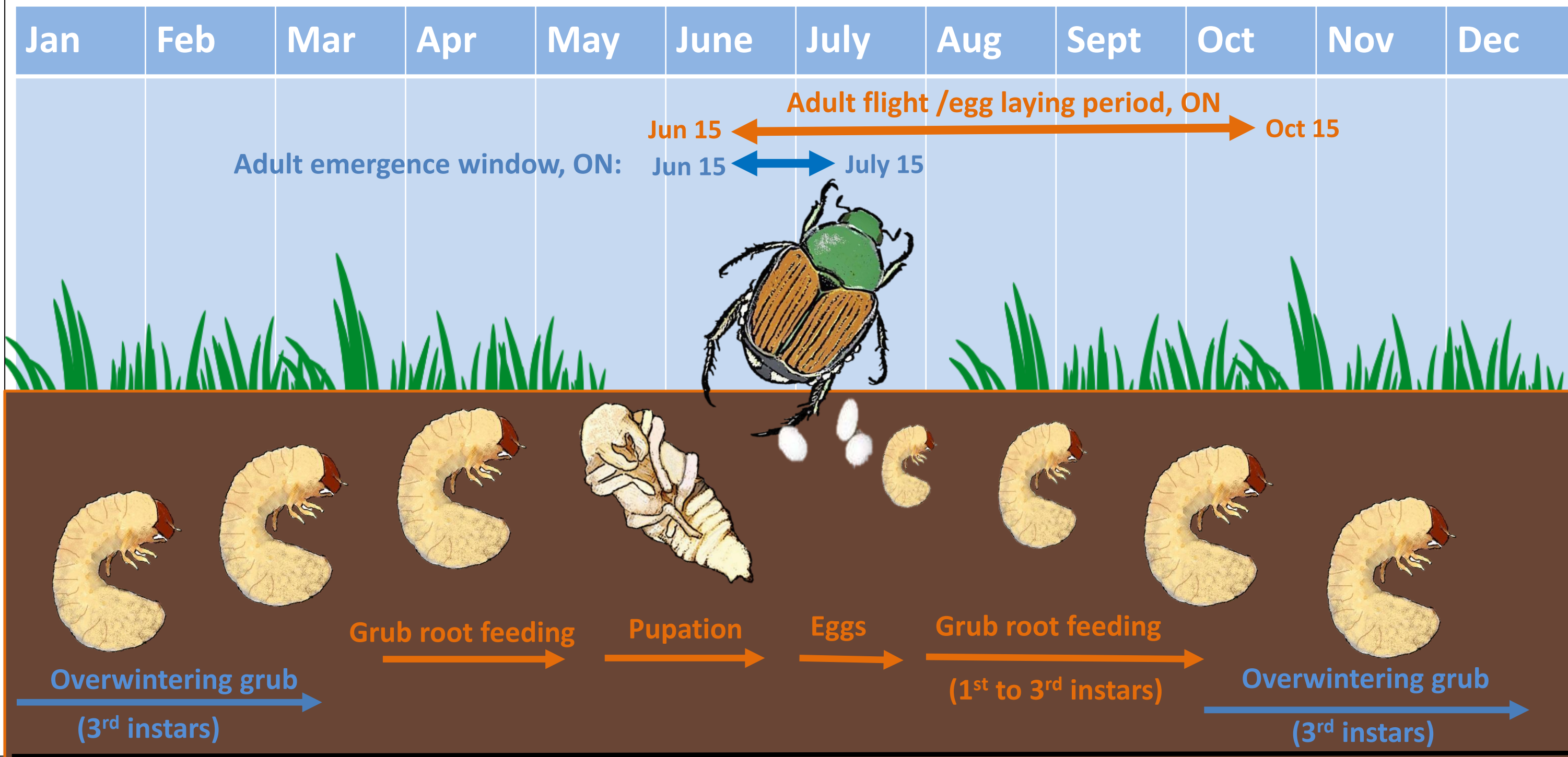


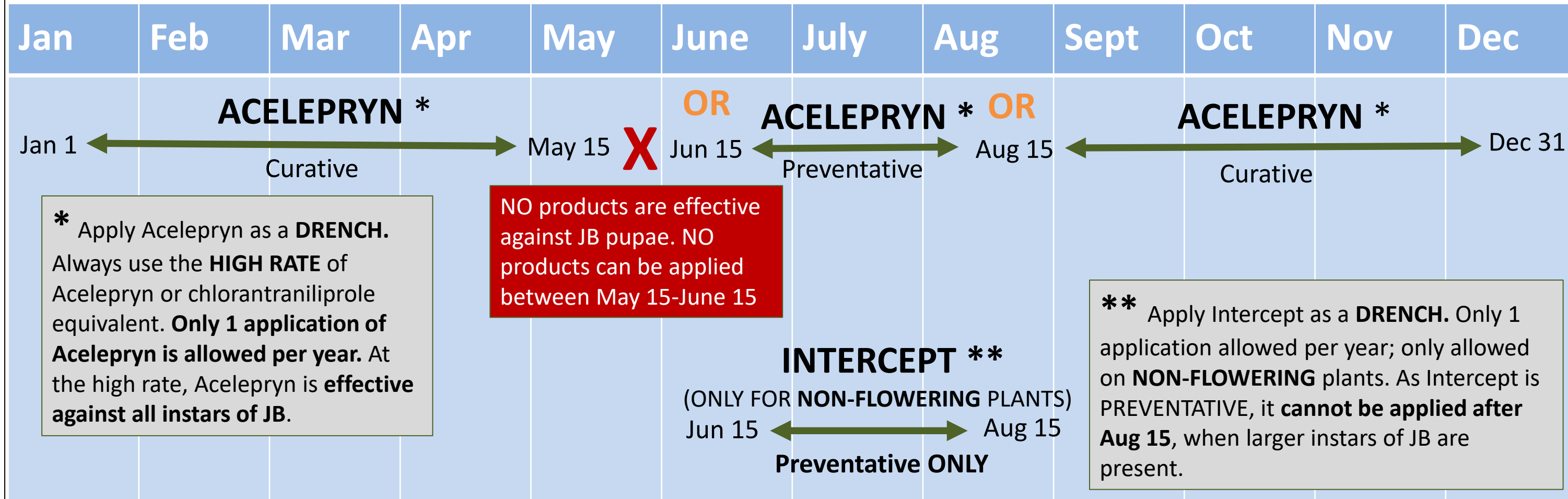


# APPLICATION TIMING FOR JB CONTROL PRODUCTS IN ONTARIO

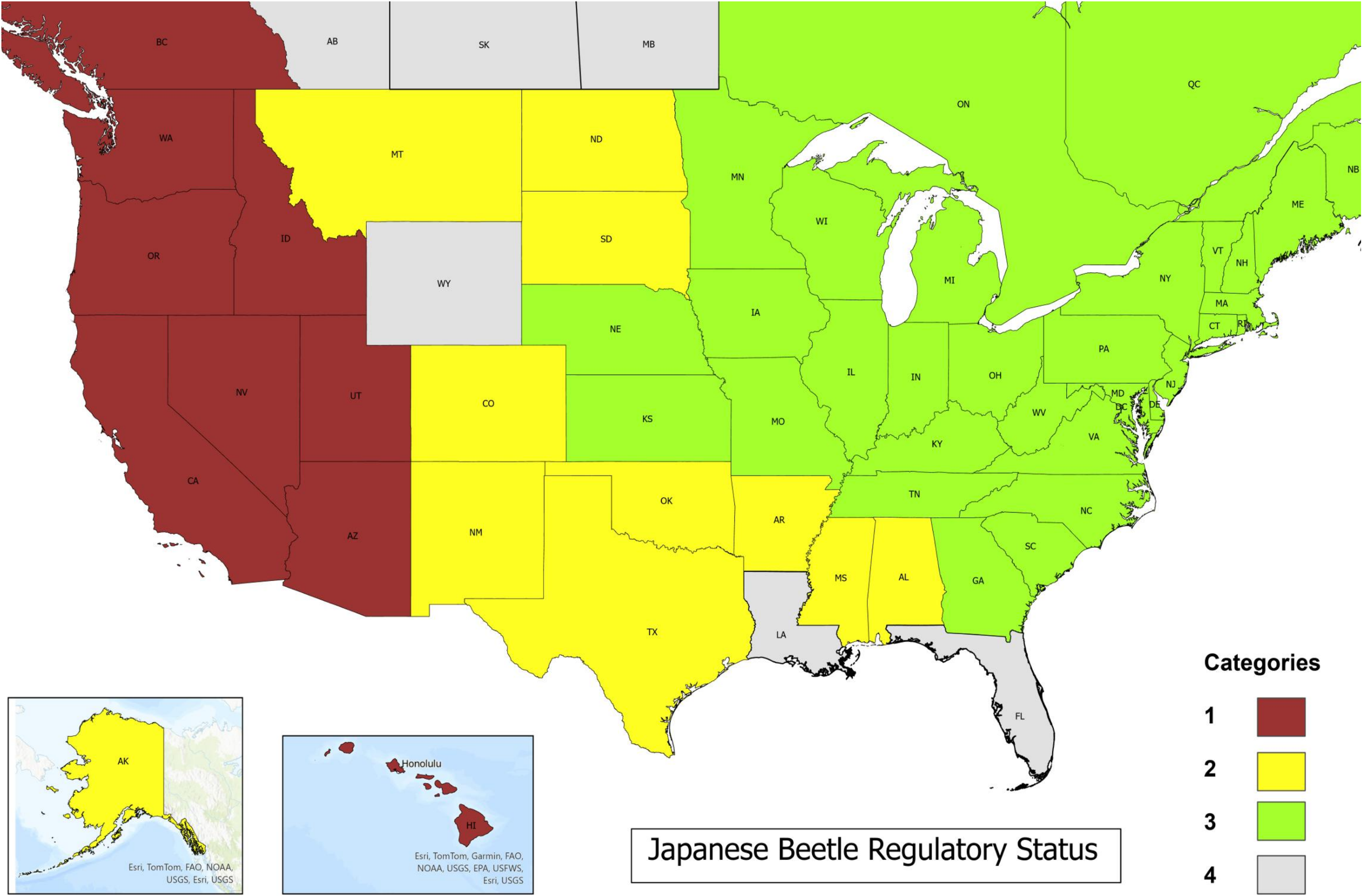
